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## INCREASE IN MILEAGE RATE FOR USE OF PERSONAL VEHICLE

Effective February 11, 2008, the reimbursement rate for an employee using a personal vehicle for business travel of 100 miles or more will be \$.38 per mile. This revised rate is based on the increased cost of operating a vehicle and the IRS increase of standard mileage rates. The travel reimbursement template has been updated for this change.
